MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE JUDICIAL RESEARCH AND TRAINING INSTITUTE
OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

AND

THE NATIONAL JUDICIAL COLLEGE

The Judicial Research and Training Institute of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Korea and the National Judicial College located in the United States of America (hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party," and collectively referred to as "the Parties"),

RECOGNIZING the need to promote and foster development of judicial education;

DESIRING to strengthen and further develop cooperation between the Parties,

HAVE AGREED as follows:

ARTICLE I OBJECTIVE

The Parties agree to promote and develop cooperation in the area of education and training of judges and mutually cooperate in the area of judicial education.

ARTICLE II AREAS OF COOPERATION

Each Party shall endeavor to encourage and promote cooperation in the following areas based on prior consultation: (a) provide education and training materials or reference materials to the other Party as appropriate; and (b) arrange and facilitate visits and cooperative activities aimed to develop skills and build capacities for job performance. Each Party shall be responsible for the costs of translation or interpretation as necessary.

ARTICLE III

EFFECT, IMPLEMENTATION, AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

This MOU has no binding legal effect. It is not intended to create or alter any existing or future legal rights. The Parties may make further agreements or arrangements for implementing program activities under this MOU.

Financial arrangements to cover expenses for the cooperative activities arising from the implementation of this MOU shall be funded by each Party unless otherwise agreed upon by the Parties in writing.

ARTICLE IV


ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This Memorandum will come into effect on the date of signing and remain in effect until terminated by either party in writing with 180 days' notice.
2. Any revision, modification, or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing.
3. This Memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties. Any amendment which has been agreed upon by the Parties shall come into effect on such date as agreed by the Parties and shall be considered an integral part of this Memorandum.
